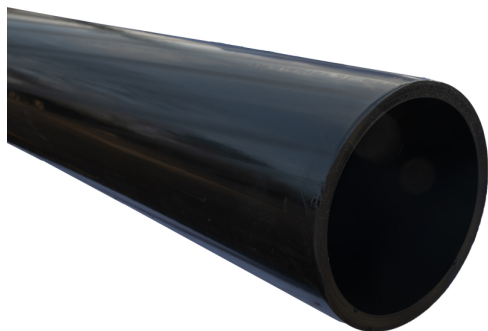


HDPE CABLE PROTECTION PIPE SDR17



Description
